2 - Three Baptisms / Three Choices

**A - Salvation / The Baptism “OF” the Holy Spirit**

**John 6:44** *“No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day.”(NASB)*

**John 3:5-6** <sup>5</sup>*Jesus answered, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. <sup>6</sup>“That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.(NASB)*

**John 14:6** *Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.(NASB)*

**B - Water Baptism / The Disciples Baptism**

**Mark 16:15-16** <sup>15</sup>*And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. <sup>16</sup>“He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; (NASB)*

**Acts 8:36-37** <sup>36</sup>*As they went along the road they came to some water; and the eunuch said, “Look! Water! What prevents me from being baptized?” <sup>37</sup>And Philip said, “If you believe with all your heart, you may.” And he answered and said, “I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.”(NASB)*

**Acts 10:44-48** <sup>44</sup>*While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who were listening to the message. <sup>45</sup>All the circumcised believers who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. <sup>46</sup>For they were hearing them speaking with tongues and exalting God. Then Peter answered, <sup>47</sup>“Surely no one can refuse the water for these to be baptized who have received the Holy Spirit just as we did, can he?” <sup>48</sup>And he ordered them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to stay on for a few days.(NASB)*
